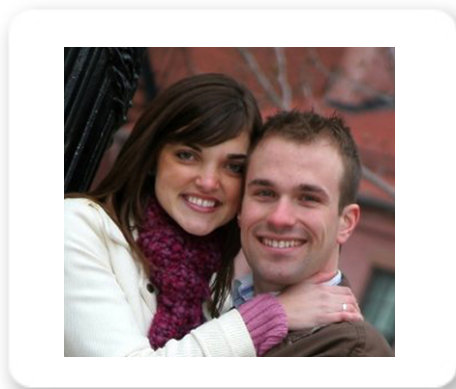


Introducing . . .
