FIELD

Ken began working in church planting with Missions Door missionary George Patterson, and in 1987 was appointed with the Mission. Ken presently serves as the Southern California Regional Ministry Specialist.

As the Regional Ministry Specialist for Southern California, Ken is responsible for the care and oversight of current Missions Door missionaries. He is also responsible for developing and recruiting future church planters to plant relevant, ethnically-diverse churches among the disenfranchised people groups of the larger Metropolitan Los Angeles area.
