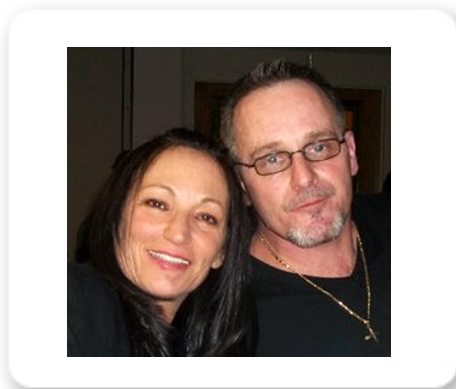

FIELD

But God saw fit to alter her path. Though she did not know Him, He knew her (Galatians 4: 8, 9). In Romans 8:29-30 it says that . . . "whom He foreknew, He also predestined to become conformed to the image of his Son."

FAMILY

She and her husband Richard have been married since 1987. Richard served several years in the New York State prison system due to drug addiction. He began doing God's work in prison. While there, he was given the opportunity to lead a 12-step meeting for inmates who were interested in recovering from drug addiction.

Richard came to know his heavenly Father on a personal level as a loving, caring, protective force in his life. Richard was released in May of 2009, and is currently involved in a local church, as he seeks from God direction for future ministry.
