Our city team pursues ministry in four areas:



Church Planting

Through both indigenous and cross-cultural church planters, we launch movements of new churches. Some of these networks reach back to a minister's country of origin via our *"from there to here and back"* focus.

Specialized Evangelism

People who are reached best by uniquely designed outreach efforts are served by missionaries singularly called and gifted to do so.

Leadership Development

Preparing Christ's disciples to serve His church in leadership roles is accomplished through a variety of indigenous training methods facilitated by our missionaries.

Ministries of Compassion and Justice

Our team seeks to be where people hurt most in the city. Working cooperatively beside men and women in their search for biblical reconciliation and justice is the goal of these missionaries.
