Ministry Focus

In 2006, Missions Door appointed Isaiás to minister among the Lenca Indians in Honduras under the oversight of Erick Sanchez. Isaiás focuses on planting churches and training leaders in the communities surrounding the city of Marcala. His wife, Olga, also serves their ministry through teaching the Bible to leaders, women and children.

The Lenca people have great spiritual and material needs, and Isaiás and Olga have seen God's hand transform many lives and communities through their ministry.

Faith Story

Isaiás grew up in San Nicolás, Intibucá, Honduras, with his parents and seven siblings. He accepted Jesus Christ as his personal Savior in 2003 and immediately felt God calling him to study His word.

Isaiás attended Instituto Bíblico Lenca (Lenca Bible Institute) in La Esperanza, Honduras for six months. He then studied for two years at the Central American Biblical Seminary of Honduras (SEBCAH) in Siguatepeque while also completing his practical ministry in the San Nicolás community. While in seminary, Isaiás met his wife Olga who was serving there on an evangelistic outreach project.

Isaiás and Olga have been married since 2006 and are the proud parents to three daughters: Melisa Esther and Melisa Sarai, twins, and Lizeth Izamar.
